## General Rules & Info:

- The contest theme is “Every Drop Counts.”
- The poster should be artistic, positive in approach, and focus on water conservation.
- Poster must be at least 11 x 8.5 inches, but not larger than 17 x 11 inches and must be in a landscape (horizontal) layout. (It reproduces better for the calendar.)
- Poster may be submitted on paper or poster board.
- Must be student’s original artwork.
- No signatures on posters!
- No syndicated, copyrighted or clipart images.
- No computer aided or copy-machine poster entries.
- A completed entry form must be attached to the back upper right corner of each poster submitted.
- Reproducibility of the poster will be a factor in the judges’ decisions, so use good lettering, bright and high contrast colors!
- Entries can be turned in at Amarillo City Hall or any Amarillo Public Library and must be received by **Noon on July 1, 2016.**
- The Texas Water Development Board “Water for Texas” Coloring Book may be used for creative ideas. Copies of “Water for Texas” may be picked up at any Amarillo Public Library, City Hall or found online at <http://tinyurl.com/twdbc coloringbook>

## Judging:

A panel of judges will select the winning posters.

There will be winners in each age group: (school year 2016-2017)

- K through 2nd Grade
- 3rd through 5th Grade
- Middle School
- High School

Posters will be judged on quality of design, creativity and originality, content and reproducibility.
